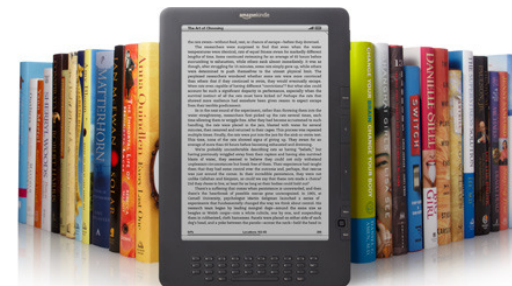

## ACCESSING E-BOOKS FROM THE ALLENDALE TOWNSHIP LIBRARY



## WHAT DO YOU NEED TO BORROW E-BOOKS?

1. A valid Allendale Township Library Card
2. A computer with Internet Access (except for iPads, iPhones, or Droid phones. With these you will need to download the free Overdrive app from the Apple App store or Droid Marketplace.)
3. A compatible e-Reader or device that uses one of the required formats: EPUB, PDF, or Kindle.

## IPAD, IPHONE, DROID PHONE



1. Go to your app store/marketplace and download the free Overdrive app on your device.
2. Click on the **Get Book** button in the upper right hand corner of the Overdrive app screen.
3. Type in your zipcode. This should bring up a new screen with the Lakeland Library Cooperative Digital Catalog. Select it.
4. This takes you to the web page for Overdrive where you may search for e-books, place holds on them, and download them directly to your device without any computer necessary.
5. Here you will need to choose your library and enter your library card number when you attempt to “check out” an e-book.
6. When your borrowing period is over, your device will tell you that your books have expired and give you the option to delete them.

## AMAZON KINDLE



1. On your computer, go to our website [www.allendalelibrary.org](http://www.allendalelibrary.org) and click on the Overdrive icon (left hand side). This will take you to the Lakeland Library Cooperative Digital Catalog and Download Center.
2. Search for the book you wish to download. (Click on **Advanced Search** to search by device format and availability). You will need to select the Kindle format.
3. To download the title, select **Add to Cart**. You will be asked to enter your library affiliation and library card number.
4. You will be taken to the screen where you can check out the book for either 7 or 14 days.
5. Once the title is checked out, click on the button **Get for Kindle**. You will now be taken to the Amazon website.
6. On the Amazon website, log in with your Amazon username/password. Once you do so, your selected title will show up on the page called **Get Your Public Library Loan**. Click on the **Get Library Book** button.
7. Select the device you wish to use and click on **Continue**. There will be a pull-down menu if you have more than one device registered with Amazon.
8. The message that you will see is that your title has been delivered to your Kindle by wi-fi (which will happen the next time your Kindle and its wi-fi access is turned on) or you can choose to transfer it by USB cable.

## NOOK, KOBO, SONY E-READER, PANDIGITAL, OR OTHER COMPATIBLE E-READER



1. On your computer, go to our website [www.allendalelibrary.org](http://www.allendalelibrary.org) and click on the Overdrive icon (left hand side). This will take you to the Lakeland Library Cooperative Digital Catalog and Download Center.
2. Before you download your first e-book, download the Adobe Digital Editions software.
3. Register the Adobe Digital Editions using an Adobe ID you create. Then plug in your device and register it.
4. Search for the book you wish to download. (Click on **Advanced Search** to search by device format and availability). You will need to select the EPUB format.
5. To download the title, select **Add to Cart**. You will be asked to enter your library affiliation and library card number.
6. You will be taken to the screen where you can check out the book for either 7 or 14 days.
7. You will be asked to either Run or Save. Select **Run**. This will place the title in your Adobe Digital Editions page. Click on the title and drag it onto the icon for your device. This will transfer the title to your device.
