What you'll need:

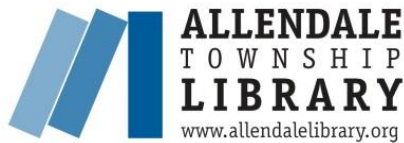
- Drawing paper
